## Building Community Together During COVID-19

Look below for some of the ways our community is supporting one another during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- The Resident Council in partnership with the Resident Emergency Response Team has taken on the responsibility of checking in with residents to maintain communication and to help people feel less isolated.
- Reece Sauvé, Chorus Director, can't meet directly with the chorus, so he sends out 7 pages of homework with music tracks to play. Everything works beautifully!
- Jerry Hull and Marian Murray are working hard at keeping the Pantry stocked with much needed items as well as setting up "curbside" pick up at the store entrance.
- Residents are hanging bags of surprises on residents' doorknobs, posting funny jokes in the elevators, and showing off their creative masks.
- The Food & Beverage staff have modified schedules, systems, and processes to fit the needs of residents, while adhering to new regulations which include establishing a separation of teams in each venue. Boston, a Lead Server in White Oak Grill, came up with an idea to create a mural to keep the teams connected. Staff in each shift creates an artistic "square" they place at their end of the mural. As the mural fills in, it will eventually meet in the middle to reunite both teams. This is a mural of hope, happiness and "the art of living well." The employees are dedicating the mural to our amazing residents who not only show us grace but compassion.
